



Course outline (1st term)

Program: Bonjour la France

Topics and Language introduced this term:

This is our first term with Bonjour la France. We will cover the lessons 1-5

This term we will do some revision of the vocabulary previously learned last year which is a great exercise as some vocabulary have been forgotten during the summer and the new pupils had the chance to learn them as well.

We will learn more vocabulary and how to compose a sentence in French.

We will also revise how to:

- do greetings (Bonjour/ salut, bonsoir, au revoir, a bientôt, bonne nuit) and how to address people (Madame/madam, Monsieur/mister, Mademoiselle/miss)
- Ask people their names (Comment t'appelle tu?)and answer: Je m'appelle,
- Tell someone where we live and ask someone where he/she lives: où habites-tu, j'habite à, en, au/I live in.

The children will learn:

-To recognize countries around France (Allemagne/Germany, la Belgique/Belgium, l'Espagne/Spain, le Luxembourg, la Suisse/ Switzerland, Italie/Italy).

-We will explain the pronunciation of U and R in French.

- To express themselves in French with more sentences using où est/ where is and answer (Je suis ici)(I am here) or je ne suis pas ici (I am not here), c'est (it is +noun)/ c'est petit, c'est grand (Is it small? Big?)

- To ask what something is (qu'est-ce-que c'est),

- To say I don't understand (Je ne comprend pas).

- The song " je ne comprends pas" and do a role play "qu'est ce que c'est".

- We will practice to make sentences with " combien de +noun" (how many ...) .

-We will revise some vocabulary like house/maison, porte/door, fenetre/window , fleur/flower, jardin/garden and learn to create more complex sentences like: il y a 2

fenetres dans la maison (there are 2 windows in the house), il y a un chat sur la fenetre (there is a cat on the window)

Or using c'est un + noun (it is a ..) ce n'est pas (it is no a ..).

-They will learn to express their tastes : “ qu'est-ce-que tu préfères? (what do you like best?)and to answer the question: Je préfère..ou (or...). J'aime ...(I like)

-They will revise the feminine and masculine words in French and do roles plays like “ah zut alors!” and sing “Quel temps fait-il?”.

They will learn how to say a few sentences like: I visit a castle/J_e visite un chateau, je reste au lit/ I stay in bed, je prépare un bon feu/ I am preparing a fire.

They will revise the animals vocabulary (oiseau/bird, papillon/butterfly, chien/dog, chat/ chat, voici (here it is) and the days of the week.

We will see how to say first, second, up to seventh (premier, deuxième... septième).

We will do a lot of role plays and will always find plenty of the time to play games in French!
